- We may not have all the answers... thank you for your continued patience.

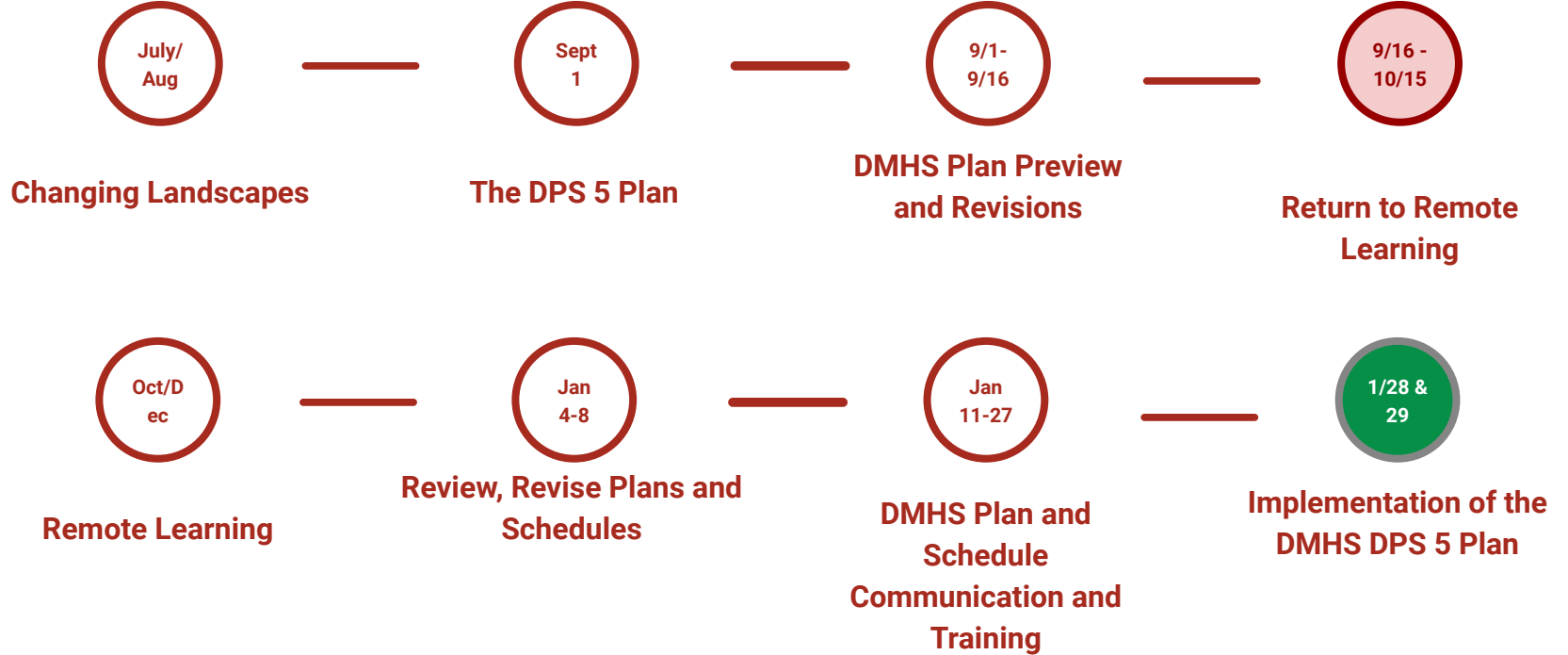

REMOTE LEARNING (RL)

This refers to August 24th-Jan 28

Most DPS secondary schools are currently in remote learning

VIRTUAL PROGRAM (VP)

This refers to family/student choice in the

AFU process. All schools will plan and support students in their own VP.

HYBRID

This refers to the plan from January 28th through the end of the second semester.

Some instruction is live and in-person (IP) and some is live and not in person (RL)

<p>Up to 2 adults with cohort at once</p> <p>Up to 4 adults assigned to cohort</p> <p>Teachers can support up to 2 cohorts</p> <p>SSPs & 1:1 paras do not count toward daily total</p>	<p>1 adult with cohort at one time</p> <p>3 adults assigned to a cohort</p> <p>Teachers (Guides) will support 2 cohorts</p> <p>Working to include SSPs and Math Specialists in the daily total of contact adults</p>
<p>3 feet social distancing, ideally 6 feet, for student-student and student-adult interactions + face mask</p> <p>6 feet social distancing required for adult-adult + face mask</p>	<p>6 feet social distancing with face mask for all interactions (student-adult and w/in the classroom setting as much as possible)</p> <p>Plexiglass dividers and barriers for side-by-side instruction. Teacher instructional space w/barrier</p>
<p>Small group pull-out allowed across cohorts up to 10 students per adult</p> <p>Adult meetings/ PD must be done virtually</p> <p>Teacher observations/ coaching limited to 1 adult observer for 15 min per day</p>	<p>Small group pull-out across 2 cohorts, w/remote live stream for additional students.</p> <p>Adult meetings/PD will continue virtually</p> <p>Teacher observations/coaching is limited to 1 adult observer no more than 15 min per day, and as much as possible the adult observer will also be 'assigned' to the cohort (counted as one of the 3 adults)</p>

DPS 5: I PROTECT YOU; YOU PROTECT ME

1 COMPLETE YOUR HEALTH SCREENING. Complete a health screening every day before entering, and please stay home if you are sick.

WEAR A MASK OR FACE COVERING. Face coverings are required, except when you are alone in your enclosed office or classroom.

MAINTAIN PHYSICAL DISTANCE. Please stay at least 6 feet away from other adults.

MEET VIRTUALLY. Please don't have adult in-person meetings or use communal spaces.

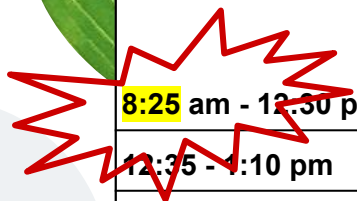
1 PRACTICE GOOD HYGIENE. Cover coughs and sneezes, and avoid touching your face. Wash your hands or use hand sanitizer.
